

**INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT**  
**ST BARNABAS CHURCH OF ENGLAND PRIMARY SCHOOL**

- 1 The name of the school is **St Barnabas Church of England Primary School**
- 2 The school is a **voluntary aided** school.
- 3 The name of the governing body is: “**The governing body of St Barnabas Church of England Primary School**”.
- 4 The governing body shall consist of:
  - a) **two** elected parent governors
  - b) **one** LA governor
  - c) **one** staff governor
  - d) **one** Headteacher
  - e) **seven** foundation governors
- 5 Total number of governors: **twelve**
- 6 St Barnabas foundation governors are appointed by the following bodies:
  - a) **two** - St Barnabas Parochial Church Council
  - b) **two** - London Diocesan Board for Schools
  - c) **two**- Westminster (St Margaret) Deanery Synod
- 7
  - a) The holder of the following office shall be a foundation governor ex-officio:  
The Priest in charge of the parish of St Barnabas.
  - b) The Archdeacon of Charing Cross shall be entitled to appoint a foundation governor to act in the place of the ex-officio foundation governor whose governorship derives from the office named in a) above, in the event that that ex-officio foundation governor is unable or unwilling to act as a foundation governor, or has been removed from office under regulation 21 (1) of the Regulations.
- 8 The Archdeacon of Charing Cross shall be entitled to request the governing body to remove the ex-officio governor referred to in 7a) above and to appoint any substitute governor.
- 9 The ethos of the school may be described in the following terms:  
Recognising its historic foundation, the school will preserve and develop its religious character in accordance with the principles of the Church of England and in partnership with the Church at parish and diocesan level.

The school aims to serve its community by providing an education of the highest quality within the context of Christian belief and practice. It encourages an understanding of the meaning and significance of faith, and promotes Christian values through the experience it offers to all its pupils.

- 10 This instrument of government comes into effect on **17<sup>th</sup> June 2015**.
- 11 This instrument was made by order of City of Westminster Local Authority on 4<sup>th</sup> June 2015.
- 12 A copy of the instrument must be supplied to every member of the governing body and to the appropriate religious body.
