The theme for this year is:

Posters can include drawings, diagrams, labels and short explanations. Children are encouraged to be as creative as they like while clearly sharing their ideas.

#### **What should the poster include?**

- A clear title based on the theme
- Creative illustrations or diagrams
- Ideas or explanations about what makes a good childhood
- Optional facts or simple research

The deadline for entries is **Thursday 26th**. Please ensure all posters are clearly labelled with your child’s name and class.

Winners will be announced on Friday. There will be a number of winners across the school.

We hope this competition will inspire thoughtful conversations at home and give children the opportunity to reflect on what matters most in their lives.
